This pattern is perfect for a first time project with just the right amount of simplicity to challenge ratio. Kids or adults feel great about creating something that is useful to our busy lives. Students will make one for every activity to keep tools and supplies ready to go!

SKILL BUILDER TECHNIQUES:

Teach beginners about fabric preparation and layout, marking techniques, both right side and wrong, how to sew an accurate seam allowance, sew a clean finish and create a casing, top stitching, and how to install a grommet. Teachers can include information on cutting a continuous bias binding, and the use of elastics in a casing, and pressing.

With 15 waist sizes, fitting is not a deterrent with this project. Make the full and flouncy 12 gore skirt just right for a petticoat, or choose a slimmer tailored look with only 8 gores. Rare sizing outside of this range is easily worked out mathematically.

SKILL BUILDER TECHNIQUES:

Continuing with Stage 1 techniques, sewing an accurate seam will be critical with this project. Teachers educate beginners on choosing appropriate fabrics and interfacing types, how to lengthen and shorten and pattern, apply interfacing, and use an appropriate seam finish. Teachers can help students gain confidence using professional techniques for installing a lapped zipper, buttons and buttonholes, and how to sew a waistband using "stitch in the ditch" technique.

This final one-size-fits-most pattern completes the remaining basics in sewing. With a solid base in sewing skills, students completing this series will be able to tackle almost any beginner sewing pattern with new confidence!

SKILL BUILDER TECHNIQUES:

Applying information learned from Stage 1 and 2 patterns, beginners switch to a 3/8" seam allowance. Teachers instruct on working with, clipping and trimming curves and darts, how to sew and the purpose of gathers, understitching, facings, linings, and the many hand stitch types. Encourage students to get creative with hat embellishments!
